Ann Templeton, is a nationally known oil/pastel-conceptual impressionist. She likes to describe her paintings as “symbolic expressions.” She has been painting with a personal commitment to excellence, since 1969. She holds art seminars nationally and internationally, lectures and teaches at art guilds and colleges, and juries competitive art shows.

Ann’s style and enthusiasm has won her awards throughout the United States and abroad. She is a major force in oil painting and is highly recognized for her teaching expertise and color usage.

Ann has been juried into numerous shows and galleries in Europe and across the USA. Among these are the Pastel Society of America, Inc. 1997 Marion Strucken-Bachman Award for Landscape; International Association of Pastel Societies – Slide Registry 1998 ; Eurofarre International Competition — Stroncone, Italy — May 1998 — 2nd place Oils; Signature Membership, Knickerbocker USA – Selected 1993.

Ann has written two books, “Color and Beyond” and “The Art of Ann Templeton: A Step Beyond.” She has two new DVD’s, “Abstracting the Landscape in Pastel” and “Abstracting the Landscape in Oil” She has also authored four other DVDs.
